

## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005 Chickasaw , Iowa [19037]**

Chickasaw is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 12,472 ranked 62nd in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Chickasaw had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,370. This PCPI ranked 58th in the state and was 90 percent of the state average, \$31,670, and 82 percent of the national average, \$34,471. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.8 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 2.5 percent and the national change was 4.2 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Chickasaw was \$19,577 and ranked 37th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Chickasaw had a total personal income (TPI) of \$353,836\*. This TPI ranked 64th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Chickasaw was \$260,313\* and ranked 60th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 0.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 2.9 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Chickasaw. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 63.5 percent of TPI (compared with 63.2 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.6 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.9 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings decreased 0.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.5 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 3.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.5 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Chickasaw decreased from \$207,428\* in 2004 to \$206,440\* in 2005, a decrease of 0.5 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$168,983\* to the 2005 estimate was 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
