For the United States, it consists of adjustments for border workers: wage and salary disbursements to U.S. residents commuting to Canada less wage and salary disbursements to Canadian and Mexican residents commuting into the United States.

<sup>6</sup> Rental income of persons includes the capital consumption adjustment.

<sup>7</sup> Proprietors' income includes the inventory valuation adjustment and the capital consumption adjustment.

<sup>8</sup> "Other" consists of the wage and salary disbursements of U.S. residents employed by international organizations and foreign embassies and consulates in the United States.
