County Business Patterns is an annual series that provides economic data by industry for companies with employees. The series excludes data on self-employed individuals, employees of private households, railroad employees, agricultural production employees, and most government employees. Non-employers account for nearly 3/4 of all businesses and roughly 3% of business activity in terms of sales and receipts. Beginning in 1998, data are tabulated by industry as defined in the North American Industry Classification System: United States, 1997 (NAICS).
